2017 assessment results

In England, primary school pupils are continuously assessed on a day-to-day basis by their teachers: this type of assessment is sometimes called *formative* as it helps the teacher to form an understanding of the child's next steps in learning. In addition, there are a number of assessments which schools are directed to report to the Government. These statutory assessments are called *summative* as they sum up the child's progress to that point:

Early Years Foundation Stage Profile at the end of Reception

Phonics screening check in Year 1

Tests at the end of Year 2 (sometimes called Key Stage 1 SATs)

Tests at the end of Year 6 (sometimes called Key Stage 2 SATs)

Results of these assessments for the end of the school year 2017 are given below.

In **Reception**, 88.5% of our children achieved a good level of development.

96% of our **Year 1** children reached the expected standard in the phonics check.

End of Key Stage tests (SATs)

As parents are aware, the Government's new expected standard for all children is now much higher than it was previously. Our **Year 2** children worked very hard on the new, harder tests and achieved the following results:

In reading, 78% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher.

In writing, 59% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher.

In maths, 74% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher.

Our **Year 6** children also worked very hard all year and achieved the following results:

In reading, 87.5% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher.

In writing, 87.5% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher.

In maths, 75% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher.

In grammar, punctuation and spelling, 87.5% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher.

In science, 100% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher.

Average scaled scores were 106 in reading and 104.7 in maths.

70.8% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher in reading, writing and maths combined.
