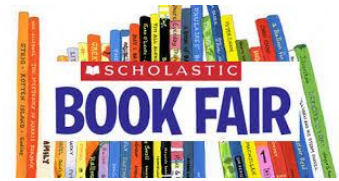


Theatre trip to Oliver! – Wednesday 25th October
