

Things to Remember

Homework Grids have been given out for the term (these are stuck inside your child's Homework Book.) Homework is due in on a Thursday and will be marked on the same day.

Daily home reading - Once your child has finished their school reading book please ask them questions about it. All reading done with an adult must be recorded in their reading record alongside a date.

Year 4 will be visiting the library on a Tuesday afternoon – this book allows them to read for pleasure and does not need to be noted in their Reading Record.

Literacy

In literacy this term we will be looking at:

- Setting Descriptions
- Newspaper Reports
- Diary Writing
- Information Texts

We will be using the novel:

- Escape from Pompeii

We will be looking closely at the structure of these text types and introducing more exciting vocabulary to engage our readers when writing for different purposes.

We will also be working on developing our paragraphing skills and using a range of punctuation.

Spellings will go home on Thursday to be tested on the following Thursday. These spelling sheets do not need to be returned.

Maths

Year 4 will be focusing on Number and place value, roman numerals, addition and subtraction, perimeter and length, multiplication and division.

We will be focusing on confidently using column method for addition and subtraction.

Year 4 children will be to practising all their times tables up to 12 x 12.

Year 4 will be doing a lot of mental arithmetic over this term.
