Literacy

In literacy this term we will be looking at:

- Letter Writing
- Information Texts/Nonchronological reports
- Explanation Texts
- Poetry

We will be using a range of fiction and non-fiction to guide our writing this term, including; FLOTSAM and The Big Book of the Blue.

We will be looking closely at the structure of these text types and introducing more exciting vocabulary to engage our readers when writing for different purposes.

We will also be working on developing our paragraphing skills and using a range of punctuation.

Maths

Year 4 will be focusing on Multiplication and Division, Area, Fractions, Decimals and Number and Place Value over Spring Term.

In Multiplication and Division we will be exploring times tables facts to 12 x 12 and multiplying 3 numbers.

In Area we will be finding the area of rectangles.

Within Fractions we will be exploring equivalent fractions, counting in hundredths, understanding non-unit fractions and adding and subtracting them too!

We will be multiplying and dividing single digit numbers by 10 and 100.

For Spring Term, Year 4 will be learning about the Watercycle, Oceans and Rivers, Plastics and Electricity.



We will be trying to find the answers to questions such as:

- What is the Great Pacific Garbage Patch?
- What impact is plastic having on wild life?
- How can we reduce and reuse the everyday plastics at home?

We hope to visit Hard Castle Craggs to learn about The Water Cycle.
