## Walsden St Peter's CE School Home – School Agreement COVID

<p>Do its best to:</p> <p>Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;</p> <p>Encourage but not insist on children to socially distance where possible</p> <p>Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;</p> <p>Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;</p> <p>Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;</p> <p>Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;</p> <p>Communicate between home and school through notices, text, email and the school website.</p>	<p>Help my child at school, I know and understand that:</p> <p>If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible;</p> <p>If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;</p> <p>When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.</p> <p>When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;</p> <p>Ensure my child only brings essential items (as defined by the school ) into school with them or take items home from school.</p> <p>Allow my child to have their temperature taken during the day if they feel or present as being unwell;</p> <p>Remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully;</p> <p>Understand that socially distancing isn't possible at all times in a school environment;</p> <p>Support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis;</p> <p>Will inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details;</p> <p><b>Do everything I can to ensure children are not mixing socially outside of school. If they do mix in large groups outside of school.</b></p>	<p>Do my best to:</p> <p>Tell an adult if I feel unwell;</p> <p>Always stay within my bubble;</p> <p>Not bring toys or stationary into school from home, or take things home from school</p> <p>Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other;</p> <p>Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate;</p> <p>Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);</p> <p>Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;</p> <p>Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;</p> <p>Follow the school rules.</p>
