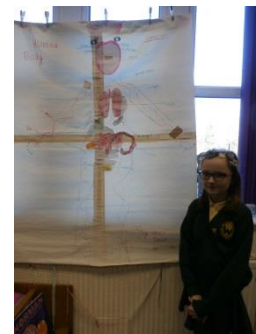
Spare clothing amnesty
